REGULATIONS

The final text of these Supplementary Regulations shall be the English version, which shall be used should any dispute arise as to their interpretation. Headings in this document are for ease of reference only and do not form part of these Supplementary Regulations.

Article 1 – Organisation

The Competition, which has the status of an International Competition, shall be run in conformity with:

- the International Sporting Code ("the Code") and its Appendices,
- the National Sporting Code where applicable,
- the official FIA Bulletins,
- the General Prescriptions applicable to International Hill Climb Competitions,
- the Sporting Regulations of the FIA International Hill Climb Cup ("the Sporting Regulations"), and
- these Supplementary Regulations.

a) **Name:** Jahodná

Location: State road No. II/547 from Košice to Spišská Nová Ves

b) **Place of the start (and altitude):**

750 m after branch road to Alpinka,
7 km after the exit from the town Košice in
direction to Spišská Nová Ves (339 metres)

d) **Difference in height:** 199 metres

Characteristics of the Competition:

a) Number of official practice heats: 3

Number of free practice heats: 2

b) Number of official race heats: 2

c) Any Driver must mandatorily complete at least one practice heat and be credited with a practice time in order to be allowed to start the race. Special cases shall be submitted to the stewards.

d) Driver classifications shall be established by combining the times of each Driver's two best race heats.

Licence requirements:

Drivers: Car driving licence and Grade A, B, C, D or R International Licence.

In Hill Climbs, the Grade R licence is not valid only for cars in Groups CN, D and E2 of Category II defined in Article 251.1.1 of the Appendix J.

In Hill Climbs, the Grade C licence (minimum) is required for cars in Groups CN, D and E2 of Category II defined in Article 251.1.1 of Appendix J.

Rejections, Withdrawals:

In the event that an entry is rejected or the Competition is cancelled, the entry fees shall be reimbursed in full.

In case of withdrawal for reasons of Force Majeure (no-show for administrative checking and scrutineering) after the publication of the entry list, 60% of the base entry fees shall be reimbursed to the Competitor(s), subject to receipt of a written request.

Article 3 – Eligible cars – Groups and Categories

3.1 Category 1 – Production cars:

The Competition is open to cars holding a national technical passport and complying with the prescriptions of Appendix J (unless otherwise indicated) for the following groups:

Group N Production cars, including Group R1.
Group A Touring cars, including World Rally Cars, Super 1600 and cars from Groups R2 and R3.
Group S20 Super 2000 cars (Circuit and Rally combined), including Groups R4 and R5.
Group GT Grand Touring cars (GT3 and RGT combined).

3.2 Category 2 – Competition cars:

The Competition is open to cars holding a national technical passport and complying with the prescriptions of Appendix J (unless otherwise indicated) for the following groups:

Group D/E2-SS (Single-seater) International Formula or Free Formula single-seater racing cars with a cylinder capacity of 3000cm ³ or below.
Group CN Two-seater production sports cars, open or closed, with a cylinder capacity of 3000cm ³ or below.
Group E2-SC (Sportscar) Two-seater competition cars, open or closed, with a cylinder capacity of 3000cm ³ or below.
Group E2-SH (Silhouette) Cars having the appearance of a large production road car with at least 2 seats and the same shaped windscreen as this car. Cylinder capacity 6500cm ³ or below.

3.3 Category 3 – E1 cars:

The Competition is open to cars holding a national technical passport and complying with the prescriptions of Appendix J (unless otherwise indicated) for the following group:

Group E1 Production, Touring or Large Scale Series Production cars having at least 4 seats (excluding 2+2), as defined by Article 277 of Appendix J, Category 1. Cylinder capacity 6500cm ³ or below.

3.4 Cars will be divided into the following cylinder classes:

Article 4 – Obligations of Participants

Competition numbers:

The organiser shall provide each participant with at least four sets of Competition numbers. Two sets of Competition numbers must be clearly displayed on both sides of the car throughout the Competition.

Two sets of Competition numbers (maximum height 15 cm) must be placed on the right side of the windscreen (or, if the car has no windscreen, on a forward-facing part of the car) and on the left side of the rear window.

Cars without their correct Competition numbers shall not be allowed to take the start.

Article 6 – Insurance

In accordance with legal requirements, the organiser has taken out one or more insurance policies against the following risks:

- Third Party Insurance in the amount of €233 000 for the event.

The organiser's third party insurance is valid for the entire duration of the Competition, not only during official practice and race heats but also for travelling from the parking area to the course of the Competition and back.

Article 7 – Protests and appeals

Protest fee: €500.

Appeal fee set by the ASN: €1340.

International appeal fee (FIA): €6000.

Any protest must be lodged in accordance with the prescriptions of the Code. Protests must be made in writing and given to the clerk of the course or to his assistant, or in their absence to a steward, accompanied by the requisite protest fees.

If the protest requires the dismantling and re-assembly of various parts of a car, the claimant must also pay a deposit which shall be set by the stewards.

Competitors have the right to appeal, as established in Articles 15.1 to 15.4 of the Code and as provided for in the regulations of the International Court of Appeal.

Article 8 – Podium, Prizes and Awards

8.1 Trophies and Cash prizes

The classifications shall be established and shall entail the distribution by the organiser of awards and cash prizes as follows:

8.2 Special prize

Record - achieving the absolute best time (during the race heats) which will overcome the current track record will be awarded by 1 Cup.

a) Trophies

In class/groups with fewer than 3 starters, only the Driver who finishes first shall receive a trophy.



b) All trophies are cumulative and may be combined with one another and with other prizes awarded by the organisers in the other jointly-organised Competitions.

c) Awarding of prizes:

Trophies are awarded during the podium Ceremony in area of RR Jahodna.

APPENDIX 1: Start Area & Service Park

1. Approach of the competing cars to start area

- a) Service park will be placed 3 km after the Finish line (in the area of RR Jahodná). All race cars must be ready on time for departure to the start area prior the crossroad on driveway to RR Jahodná. Race cars are to be ordered in the starting order. The vehicle of the Clerk of the course will approach to Start as last one. No competing car may follow it.
- b) Each race car may be accompanied to Start area with one small service vehicle which will be clearly marked by sticker "START" supplied by the organizer.
- c) Drivers must follow safe distance between vehicles, It is strictly prohibited to overtake or stop on the track. After reaching the starting area, the race and service vehicles will turn and take their posts front of the starting line.
- d) Damaged cars may return to the paddock from the track so that they shall slot in between service vehicles on their return to the paddock. Broken-down cars will be removed from the track after the end of practice or race heats with the exception authorized by the Clerk of the course.
- e) All infringements of these rules will be announced to the Stewards which may decide about penalty.

2. Service park

- a) Service park will be opened on Thursday, 17.5.2018.
- b) Service park location: Parking places in area of RR Jahodná, 3 km from Finish line.
- c) Entry into Service parks A, B is allowed only for race cars and vehicles marked by sticker „Service” or „Start”. All other cars must be placed into the marked parking places. Any infringement will be penalised by the Clerk of the Course by cash penalty up to €300.
- d) Parking of the trailers inside of the Service park is forbidden. They must be placed in the special area reserved by organizer.
- e) The speed of race cars and service vehicles may not exceed 5 kph in the area of the service park and 30 kph the road to Start area. Every infringement of this rule may be penalised by the Stewards.
- f) Organisers will not provide guard of the service park.

3. Arrival to RR Jahodná

Arrival is available only until 08:00 during the days 19.-20.05.2018.
